| Putnam | 5/6 and 6/7 | We have eliminated early release days for the grading periods. We have full day planning for teachers. | We have 3 early release days scheduled for the last 3 days of school. This is the first year that we have tried this schedule. The reason is to allow teachers to use those afternoons to prepare their rooms for the summer. Because of this we have eliminated post planning days and the teachers are finished the last day of school after they have completed their check-out forms. |
| Seminole | 5/6, 6/6, 6/7, and Block | 1 hour every Wednesday | <i>Not provided (36?)</i> |
| St. Johns | 6/7 and Block | One per semester | Two |
