

What is Meet Up?

Students meet daily in a circle to greet one another, share, monitor Harmony Goals, solve problems, and engage in community building activities.

Time: 5 -15 minutes


Establish Harmony Goals

Model good listening and conversation strategies.


Listeners ask two clarifying questions, respond, and offer empathetic comments.

3.1 Listening and Responding to Others Communication Do's and Don'ts Cards (P. 215)

Look at the person speaking	Sing, hum, or make noise	Give each person a turn to talk	Keep my body still
Talk over the person speaking	Nod my head to show that I hear what is said	Wait quietly for my turn to speak	Think about what I want to say
Ask questions if I don't understand	Look away from the speaker	Think about what the speaker is saying	Pay attention to the person speaking






