If passed, might impose 2/3rd SB/BOCC vote for millage increases





2016-2022 GENERAL ELECTION MILLAGE


Republican counties: 11-0; avg.: 64% Democratic counties: 7-1; avg.: 69%





2016-2022 GENERAL ELECTION SALES TAX

Republican counties: 14-2; avg.: 59% Democratic counties: 4-0; avg.: 63%














Net >10 points faves

= ~2 points on ballot




POLLING AND BALLOT DYNAMICS

- BROWARD: -6 POINTS







2022 GENERAL BALLOTS

- ST. LUCIE: -4 POINTS








Elevator-Anchor Analysis



VOTER FREQUENCY AND MESSAGE FAVORABILITIES: PRESIDENTIAL VS. OFF-YEAR
