


It's Elementary

- 1. Investigations are administrative, not criminal

 - c. Law enforcement notifications

Master Contract (XI.1)

Disciplinary Action shall be defined as any action that includes: warning conference, verbal reprimand, written reprimand, suspension with pay, suspension without pay, involuntary transfer, and/or dismissal.

Employees shall be notified at least 24 hours in advance of any meeting which may result in disciplinary action and shall be informed in writing that he/she is entitled to representation.
